

## Remote Scoring Display

The **BT 4000** features a remote scoring display that brings electronic scoring right to the "toe-line". Toe-line scoring allows the dart player to see electronic scores up close and personal. No longer do you have to walk up to the dartboard every time in between dart throws to check your cricket marks or opponent's points. Toe-line scoring also keeps the electronic display safe and away from incoming darts!

The remote display can be used up to 9 1/2 feet away from the dartboard. There are infra red sensors located on both the base of the dartboard and on the remote scoring display. The infra red sensors have directional arrows on the covers and are illustrated below.

The arrows need to be pointed towards each other for the scoring to register. The remote scoring display can be moved to both sides of the dartboard but cannot exceed a 45 degree angle. This allows spectators to control the scoring without getting in the way of the dart match. The display can be held or even be put on a table top for convenience.
